What is the 4-H Clover Award? This is an award to recognize your involvement as a 4-H member in the Greene County 4-H Program. Members earn points for participating and excelling in the 4-H club, county, state, national and international levels as well as all four clover areas- Head, Heart, Hands, and Health. Every 4-H member who participates is a winner. Only 4-H members, at least 8 and in the 3rd grade to age 18, are eligible to receive a Clover Award.

Completing the Record Sheet:

- Only 4-H members who complete this record sheet and return it to the Extension Office (check calendar for date), will be eligible to receive a gold, silver or bronze pin at the Greene County 4-H Awards Program.
- Document your 4-H activities from last years fair until the day before this year's fair starts.
- Check all appropriate activities and provide the requested information.
- The 4-H club member and advisor must sign this completed form. 4-H advisor's signature verifies the 4-H member's participation in activities indicated.
