We strive to ensure a strong scientific basis behind the best practices taught and recommended by our team, provide helpful tools and resources to develop risk assessments and food safety plans for the farm, and promote high-quality, safe produce from Ohio growers.

Anyone who sells produce at local farmers' markets should consider attending. Additional information may include a proposal from the FDA that will revise requirements on water quality and testing, manure and compost application, and wildlife intrusion.
