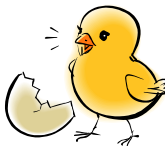
Dear Teacher,

Information on our **"4-H in the Classroom – Chick Quest"** teaching kit for the current **school year** is attached. This 4-H kit is "teacher-friendly" - lessons, incubator, and supplies are included. **Cost to borrow the kit is \$30.** These fees help defray the cost of non-re-usable kit supplies and incubator maintenance / replacement. We are very excited that we will be purchasing some new incubators and thermometers over the course of the next school year! We currently have 22 kits available.

**To reserve a 4-H teaching kit, complete and return the enclosed form.** Booking policy is "first-received; first-served." **EACH TEACHER NEEDS TO FILL OUT A REGISTRATION FORM.** Please do not put more than one teacher on the form. Please share this information with other teachers who might be interested in our program.

Fees **MUST** be paid prior to kit pick-up, unless other arrangements are made. The bill for fees is the confirmation letter with your "borrow date".

You are provided with an incubator, 12 fertilized chicken eggs, food, water basin, sponge, cheesecloth, poster, and a teacher's guide. Hatched chicks will be raised on a local farm. A "back up batch" of chicks will be available in case of unforeseen situations that may cause a poor hatch for you. **Kit cost \$30.**

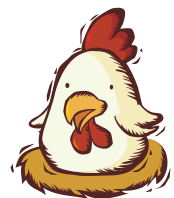

If there are multiple teachers at one school, one teacher may pick-up / return the kits for you.

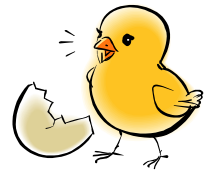
