4-H Scholarship on behalf of Vet Associates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This scholarship is sponsored through the Veterinary Associates Animal Hospital in Xenia. • Applicant must be in their senior year of high school planning on attending a college or university the following year, a freshman in college, or a former 4-H member (19 years of age or older) presently attending an institute of higher education.
4-H Scholarship on behalf of Gail Heider Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This was established by the family of Gail Heider and friends to honor the many years of dedicated service that she provided to the youth of Greene County. • Applicant must be in their senior year of high school planning on attending a college or university the following year, a freshman in college, or a former 4-H member (19 years of age or older) presently attending an institute of higher education.
Goat	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicant must be a senior in high school and a resident of Greene County • Must be current 4-H / FFA member taking a goat project and has taken a goat project the past two consecutive years at the Greene County Fair • Applicant can use scholarship money at any accredited post-secondary educational opportunity (college, vocational or technical school) • Applicant must be accepted by an accredited institution and present a letter from the institution before money is awarded • Winner will be announced the week of Greene County Fair and a certificate will be presented • A check will be sent to the institution that the scholarship winner will be attending
Rabbit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This scholarship will be awarded to Greene County seniors in high school who meet all the guidelines. The committee may award up to four scholarships each year. The amount of each scholarship award will be \$125.00. • The applicant must be a senior in high school. • He or she must have exhibited a rabbit project for the past three (3) consecutive years at the Greene County Fair. • Applicants can use scholarship money at any accredited post-secondary educational opportunity (college, vocational or technical school). • The winner or winners will be announced at the trophy presentation at the Rabbit Show at the fair each year. A certificate will be presented at that time. A check will be sent to the institution that the scholarship winner will be attending. • The scholarship money must be used within the year of receipt. • Applicant must be accepted by an accredited institution and present a letter from the institution before money is awarded.
Poultry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High school senior or college freshman. • Resident of Greene County or has attended Greene County schools. • Must be current 4-H member and has taken at least three years of a poultry project. • Applicant can use scholarship money at any accredited post-secondary educational opportunity (college, vocational, or technical school). A check will be sent to the institution that the scholarship winner will be attending.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicant must be accepted by an accredited institution and present a letter from the institution before money is awarded • Winner will be announced the week of the Greene County Fair.
Horse	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High school senior • Must be current 4-H member and have taken at least three years of a horse project • Applicant can use scholarship money at any accredited post-secondary educational opportunity (college, vocational, or technical school). A check will be sent to the institution that the scholarship winner will be attending. • Applicant must be accepted by an accredited institution and present a letter from the institution before money is awarded.
