4 4-H Advisory Committee Scholarship	Applicant must be in their senior year of high school planning on attending a college or university the following year
4 4-H Scholarship on behalf of Vet Associates	<ul> <li>This scholarship is sponsored through the Veterinary Associates Animal Hospital in Xenia.</li> <li>Applicant must be in their senior year of high school planning on attending a college or university the following year, a freshman in college, or a former 4-H member (19 years of age or older) presently attending an institute of higher education.</li> </ul>
Goat	<ul> <li>Applicant must be a senior in high school and a resident of Greene County</li> <li>Must be current 4-H / FFA member taking a goat project and has taken a goat project the past two consecutive years at the Greene County Fair</li> <li>Applicant can use scholarship money at any accredited post-secondary educational opportunity (college, vocational or technical school)</li> <li>Applicant must be accepted by an accredited institution and present a letter from the institution before money is awarded</li> <li>Winner will be announced the week of Greene County Fair and a certificate will be presented</li> <li>A check will be sent to the institution that the scholarship winner will be attending</li> </ul>
Rabbit	<ul> <li>This scholarship will be awarded to Greene County seniors in high school who meet all the guidelines. The committee may award up to four scholarships each year.</li> <li>The applicant must be a senior in high school.</li> <li>He or she must have exhibited a rabbit project for the past three (3) consecutive years at the Greene County Fair.</li> <li>Applicants can use scholarship money at any accredited post-secondary educational opportunity (college, vocational or technical school).</li> <li>The winner or winners will be announced at the trophy presentation at the Rabbit Show at the fair each year. A certificate will be presented at that time. A check will be sent to the institution that the scholarship winner will be attending.</li> <li>The scholarship money must be used within the year of receipt.</li> <li>Applicant must be accepted by an accredited institution and present a letter from the institution before money is awarded.</li> </ul>
Poultry	<ul> <li>High school senior or college freshman.</li> <li>Resident of Greene County or has attended Greene County schools.</li> <li>Must be current 4-H member and has taken at least three years of a poultry project.</li> <li>Applicant can use scholarship money at any accredited post-secondary educational opportunity (college, vocational, or technical school). A check will be sent to the institution that the scholarship winner will be attending.</li> <li>Applicant must be accepted by an accredited institution and present a letter from the institution before money is awarded</li> <li>Winner will be announced the week of the Greene County Fair.</li> </ul>
Horse	<ul> <li>High school senior</li> <li>Must be current 4-H member and have taken at least three years of a horse project</li> <li>Applicant can use scholarship money at any accredited post-secondary educational opportunity (college, vocational, or technical school). A check will be sent to the institution that the scholarship winner will be attending.</li> <li>Applicant must be accepted by an accredited institution and present a letter from the institution before money is awarded.</li> </ul>
