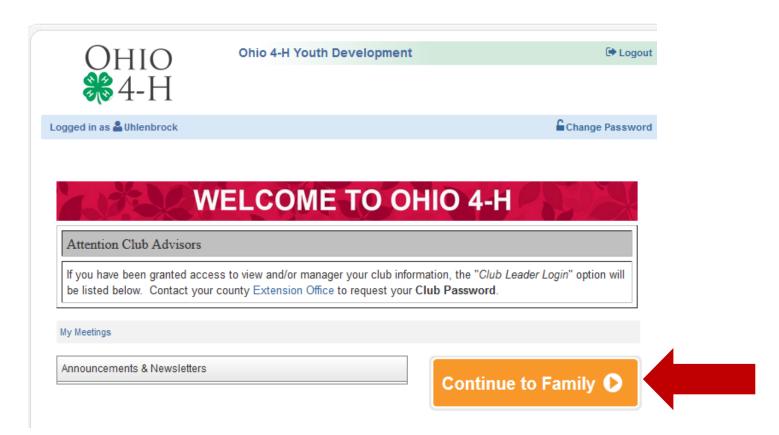

Current 4-H Volunteers in Greene County who have completed at least 2 years of previous, continuous service (2016 and 2017) are able to do this.

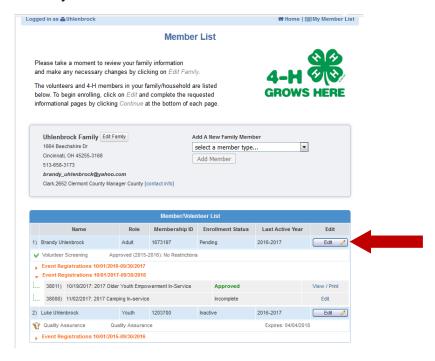
Instructions:

- Log in to your FAMILY account on 4H Online (4honline.com) using Firefox.
 Firefox is the only browser that will work for online trainings.
- Choose Ohio as the state.
- Please re-enroll yourself as a volunteer and update information prior to completing the trainings. Your status will show as "Pending".
- Select "Continue to Family" (orange button).

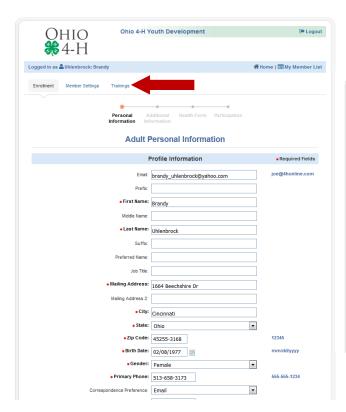




- You will see a list of all family members who are members or volunteers.
- Find your name and select "Edit".

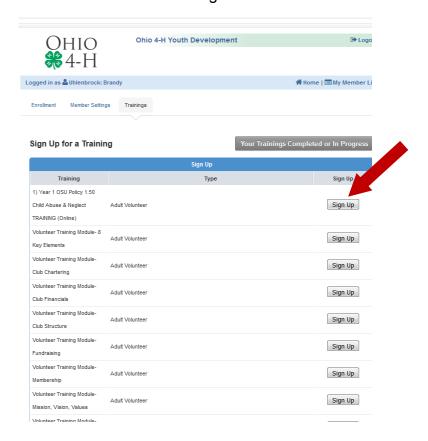


- Select "Trainings".

- Click "Sign Up" beside the trainings you would like to complete.
- Choose "Edit/View" to begin each module.



To meet requirements you must complete three modules by February 22

- 1. Year 1 OSU Policy 1.50 Child Abuse and Neglect Training
- 2. OSU Policy 1.50 Child Abuse and Neglect Quiz
- 3. Any Additional module of your choice:
 - 8 Key Elements
- Club Financials
- Club Structure
- Mission, Vision, Values
- Membership

You may complete them all in one sitting or do them at three different times, but it doesn't work well to pause in the middle of a module. You must receive a passing score on each quiz to receive credit. Trainings may be repeated if needed.

Please note: At least one volunteer for each club must still attend an in person training to obtain a club packet.

Every volunteer must complete ONE approved training each year to remain active. This training meets that requirement.
