
Goodbye!



QA Training Dates

Wednesday, April 5, 5:30 PM Thursday, April 27, 5:30 PM Monday, May 22, 5:30 PM Locations will Be Announced

Any youth wishing to exhibit an animal at the fair in 2023 is required to complete Quality Assurance. Quality Assurance for exhibition at the Greene County Fair must be completed by June 1st. Any youth wishing to exhibit at the Ohio State Fair MUST complete Quality Assurance prior to the start of the OSF.

New in 2023! Greene County 4-H will be accepting online QA certificates. The online module completed must be for the correct 4-H age. Only the YQCA courses currently meet ODA standards. BQA, PQA, BEST and other online programs do not meet this requirement. Families use their 4HOnline log in to complete the course. The cost is \$12 per youth. Program details: www.go.osu.edu/gcyqca

 All Greene County 4-H Exhibitors need to complete an in-person or online QA before the June 1 deadline. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!

Birth Rabbit Dates for 2023 Fair

- Meat Pen and Single Fryer = 5/21/2023
- Roasters= 01/31/23- 04/30/23 with a maximum weight of 9 pounds, Must be at least 3 months old.
- Seniors = 11/30/2022 and earlier
- 6/8 = 12/01/22 01/30/23
- Juniors = 01/31/23 04/30/23
- Pre-Juniors = 05/06/23 06/03/23
- Fancy D&L = 05/20/23 06/03/22
- Commercial D&L = 05/20/23 06/03/23
- Matching Breeding Pair = 01/30/23 and earlier Recommended Breeding Dates for Meat Pens and Single Fryers
- 4/21/2023: This is 100 days prior to the show day. Remember that each individual rabbit must weigh between 3.5 and 5.5 pounds. Any under or overweight rabbits will be ineligible for placing in the show.

Cats, Sheep, Goats, Rabbits, Beef Breeding,

Hog Projects – May 8

Leasing of Animals

Greene County 4-H does allow breeding animal/dairy leases. These forms are *required* to be on file with our office. The deadline to turn these in is May 1, 2023. Examples of leases can be found on our website

These leases are required to be in place by May 1, 2023 and go until the completion of the project.
