SKILLATHONS

Livestock skillathons will take place on July 20 and July 21. Hours will be 9-12 a.m. on July 20 and 3-6 p.m. on July 21.

A change is happening with this for 2021. Youth will be using iPads to complete their livestock skillathons. Youth will need to bring books too as this will still be part of the evaluation process.

DRUG USE NOTIFICATION FORM (DUNF)

As with 2020, we will continue to use an Online Drug Use Notification Form (DUNF). This form will need to be completed by Friday, July 30, 2021 at noon. As a reminder, this form is REQUIRED for each MARKET/LACTATING animal. In addition, a few other species require it. **If your animal is listed below, fill out this electronic DUNF form by Tuesday, August 4 at 8:00 a.m.** Please review this document to help you complete this.

Cattle

- Large Market Beef (steer/heifer)
- Veal Calf (not a feeder)
- Dairy Steer
- Lactating Dairy Cattle (cow not a heifer)

Swine

- Market Hog (barrow/gilt)

Goat

- Dairy Market (wether/doe) Must use scrapie ID#
- Meat Market (wether/doe) Must use scrapie ID#
- Lactating Dairy Goats (even if currently dry)

Poultry

- Market Chicken pen
- Each Market Turkey
- Each Market Duck

Sheep

- Market Lamb Must use scrapie ID#

Rabbit

- Meat pen

4-H CULTURAL IMMERSION TRIP

The best way to understand a different culture is to immerse yourself in it. Apply to be part of the Cultural Immersion project experience in Puerto Rico. You will build multicultural skills and understanding, as well as an increased ability to communicate in the increasingly diverse society that we live in. You will experience both the Old San Juan urban area as well as life in the remote mountain town of Castañer. We will also be working with 4-H youth from Puerto Rico in joint service projects.

Teens ages 15-19 (as of date of trip) are eligible for this 8-day service-learning experience. The cost of the experience is \$500 plus airfare (est. \$600). Limited scholarship funds are also available.

I would love to see Greene County youth participate. I attended this as a 4-H professional several years ago and it was wonderful. Feel free to ask me any questions!

4-H will sponsor the Buyer Thank You Poster Contest for members taking market animals.

1. Posters should be no bigger than 11"14"
2. It is suggested to use a foam board or laminate the poster since it is sturdy and easier to mount. **Posters must be up by Saturday, July 31 at 8:00 p.m.**
3. Posters must include first and last name as well as club name. Place or hang poster up. Winning posters will be notated and recognized by ribbons on their pens. Top 2 posters from each species will be chosen and recognized with a ribbon and an additional 4-H prize. If you win, you must claim your prize at the OSUE Office.
