Accommodations: Youth with Special Needs

- 4-H welcomes and encourages youth with special needs to participate and will make reasonable accommodations. The Winning 4-H Plan enables youth to tailor the 4-H experience to their needs and helps maintain a positive relationship between the youth's family, 4-H volunteers, and county 4-H professionals
- Youth must submit a Winning 4-H Plan Request Form by July 1. A county 4-H professional will review the request and contact you with any questions. They will consider whether making accommodations fundamentally alters the event or provides significant advantage or disadvantage to anyone participating. Judges are expected to follow accommodations.
- The completed form needs to be stapled in the front cover of the project book. The 4-H professional will share appropriate information with those who need it

- For youth that qualify at a PAS show and intend to show at the Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show, they must upload a copy of their completed out-of-county PAS Show form to their 4H Online account by 1:00pm on July 1, 2022.
- Exhibitors intending to show at the Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show must upload a copy of their equine's current negative Coggins test (dated on or after January 1, 2022) to their 4H Online account by 1:00pm on July 1, 2022.
- A step-by-step guide to entering/uploading required horse information to 4HOnline is available online at horse.osu.edu.
- It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to submit their entry and pay their \$50 stall fee online at www.ohiostatefair.com https://ohlive.fairwire.com/ by 1:00 pm by July 1, 2022.

In summary, the following information must be submitted in order for an exhibitor to be able to compete at the Ohio State Fair Junior Horse Show:

- Out-of-County PAS Approval Form (if applicable); uploaded to the exhibitor's 4H Online account no later than July 1, 2022.
- Junior Horse Show entry and \$50 stall fee; made online at https://ohlive.fairwire.com/ no later than July 1, 2022.
- Current negative Coggins test; uploaded to the exhibitor's 4H Online account no later than July 1, 2022.
- PAS Verification Form; emailed to <u>cole.436@osu.edu</u> by the PAS Show Manager or County 4-H Educator no later than July 1, 2022.



Important Reminders and Instructions


- The Jr. FairEntry system will **open on June 1** for all projects. All Jr. Fair Entries are **due by end of work day July 5, 2022.**
- All Jr.Fair entries must be made through the website: http://GreeneOhio.fairentry.com
- Recommended browsers: Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, or Safari. Older versions of Internet Explorer may cause unexpected results.
- Register all entries for each exhibitor in the entire family before proceeding to the Payment section. Please add showmanship when completing entries.
- Be sure to click the "Submit" button when you have completed your entries. Entries are not final until they have been submitted.
- Once you have submitted your entries, check your email inbox for a confirmation email with a list of your entries. You will receive another email when your entries have been approved.




Creating Entries

Each exhibitor can have multiple entries. One entry must be made for each item, animal, class, etc. For example, if an exhibitor is bringing 2 rabbits, two entries into 2 different classes must be created. If an exhibitor is showing one horse in 5 events, five class entries must be created. Once all entries have been created for the first exhibitor, you have the choice of creating another exhibitor in this family (and entries) or proceeding to check-out.

1. Click Add an Entry beside the correct exhibitor (if more than one has been created).




- 2. Click "Select" beside the first department you wish to enter.
- 3. After you select a department, you will see a list of divisions to select from, and then a list of available classes. Also notice that there are blue "Change" links in case you mistakenly select an incorrect department, division, or class.
- 4. After you have selected the class, click the green Continue button.



If this is a market goat from tag-in, market
lamb from tag-in, or market beef from
weigh-in you will be able to add the animal
directly. This information was based off of
what was submitted at the time.

If it is not one of those species, you will follow "Add animal from scratch"






7. Any questions related to entry in this class will be next. Click Continue after answering those questions.

The Review screen allows you to double check this entry for accuracy and make any changes necessary. When the information is correct, click Continue and that class entry is complete.




- 8. When each class entry is complete, you have 3 choices for what to do next:
 - a. If all class entries have been completed for one exhibitor, you can Register another Exhibitor in this family.
 - b. If this exhibitor has more class entries to make, you can **Add** another Entry for this Exhibitor. You will not be able to add another entry until the first one is approved so please complete all entries for each exhibitor before submitting.
 - If all entries for all exhibitors in the family have been completed, click
 Continue to Payment to finalize and submit your entries.






9. Review your entries for completeness and accuracy. *Notice the Summary and Detail buttons at the top of the list on the right*. If there are errors, click on the green Entries section at the top of the page. Click Continue when all information is correct.




10. Read the conditions on payment screen.

You can click the detail button to see what was submitted. Once it looks correct, click the green Continue button.





11. Read the information in the "After you Submit" section. Click Submit to finalize the entries for the exhibitors in this family. After you click Submit, no changes are possible to these entries.



12. Once you click submit – check your e-mail for a confirmation message listing your entries. If you don't receive an e-mail confirmation <u>OR</u> if you notice any errors– email our office ASAP to make the changes.

Rejected entries need to be fixed and resubmitted by the deadline.

All Jr. Fair Entries are due in FairEntry by end of work day on July 5.
