Ohio Special Needs Camp

When: June 17 - 19, 2022

"4-H is for everyone," but sometimes accessibility issues deny youth with unique abilities the opportunity to attend camp. In Ohio, a statewide 4-H camp is held at Canter's Cave 4-H Camp in Jackson, Ohio for young people who have needs that cannot be accommodated for a traditional camp and their caregivers. Being a typical kid is what Camp is all about and it is no different for youth with special needs. Our goal is to give Campers a true experience of Camp while meeting their needs and letting them set their own pace for fun and success! It gives youth a chance to try new things in a safe environment while building relationships. The youth, along with their caregivers, enjoy 2 nights and 2 days of camping experience that may not have been available otherwise through 4-H. Rabbit Rule Change for 2022

For 2022 as a trial the Greene County Rabbit Committee has removed the requirement for the special character tattoo for the meat pens and single fryers. The animals will still need unique identification tattoos. There will not be a mandatory day in July to bring your animals to fair. We will still have time to offer identification tattoos for these animals and all breeding rabbits.

Hog Pictures - DUE MAY 12

Pig secure date is May 5, 2022.

Pictures of secured hogs must be turned into the Extension Office by 4:00 p.m. on May 12, 2022. Hard copy pictures will only be accepted. NO electronic copies, including but not limited to emailed pictures, faxed pictures, cd-disc pictures, flash-drive pictures, etc. **MUST BE PRINTED PICTURES, NO EXCEPTIONS.** The pictures must show the ear notches of each pig and the side view of each pig. On the back of the picture please list the exhibitors name, club name and gender of the hog. Please note; if there are multiple siblings and pigs, you are permitted to put all siblings name on the same picture.

All 4-H and FFA Exhibitors need to register animals and reserve your animal and tack pens for the 2022 Greene County Fair. This includes dogs and horses.

Accommodations: Youth with Special Needs

- 4-H welcomes and encourages youth with special needs to participate and will make reasonable accommodations. [The Winning 4-H Plan](#) enables youth to tailor the 4-H experience to their needs and helps maintain a positive relationship between the youth's family, 4-H volunteers, and county 4-H professionals
- Youth must submit a Winning 4-H Plan **Request Form by July 1**. A county 4-H professional will review the request and contact you with any questions. They will consider whether making accommodations fundamentally alters the event or provides significant advantage or disadvantage to anyone participating. Judges are expected to follow accommodations.
- The completed form needs to be stapled in the front cover of the project book. The 4-H professional will share appropriate information with those who need it
