Additional Fair Updates

1. Be on the look out for an email sent the week before fair. Greene County is using an online system for Drug Use Notification Forms (DUNF). We will get more information out including a how to sheet. It is very easy and user friendly. The email should be sent by Tuesday, July 28. This is very important to complete this form so please take the time to do so.
2. Are you bring a purebred to fair? Any animal classified as purebred needs to have all paperwork proving it is a purebred. This paperwork needs to be presented at weigh-in. If it is not presented and confirmed, the animal shows in the crossbred class.
3. Have you reviewed the schedule for fair?

4. **4-H Miscellaneous judging, Fashion Revue and 4-H Events.** 4-H Non-livestock Project Judging is being held virtually with videos and a picture due by 11:59 p.m. July 6. The following 4-H contests have been cancelled for 2020: Egg toss, Nutrition Baking Contest, Best of the Bakers, Style Revue, Open Modeling, Table Setting Contest. For more info on non-livestock judging and requirements for virtual submission, visit www.go.osu.edu/greeneco2020judging Only youth who complete their virtual judging submission will be able to receive their non-livestock credit for fair pass and fair bucks.
5. **Skill-a-thons** will be cancelled for 2020 ONLY. Livestock judging will not be able to take place either. As a result, there will be no champion exhibitor for 2020.
6. There will be no 4-H **straw bale contest** for 2020.
7. There will not be a **4-H Awards Ceremony or a Cloverbud Graduation** but there will be a designated time and location for 4-H members to pick up their 4-H project judging awards. This will be a pickup outside of the OSU Extension Office. This will take place Friday, August 7 from 9:00 a.m.-11:00 a.m. outside of the Extension Office.
8. **Cloverbuds-** If youth want their stick horse on display, we will have put it in the Dining Hall. This is not mandatory. We would need the stick horses dropped off by Friday, July 31, 2020 in the FAIR OFFICE, NOT THE EXTENSION OFFICE. After a lot of consideration, we will not be having the stick horse race this year but it can be displayed during fair.

4-H TEEN LEADERSHIP COUNCIL (TLC) APPS.

Applications and more information to be an Ohio 4-H Teen Leadership Council (TLC) member are now available online at: go.osu.edu/TLC. Please note applications (and other materials, including letters of recommendation) are due (not postmarked; received!) by Friday, August 14, 2020.

Age: Individuals must be 14-18 as of January 1 the year of application to apply for council member, committee member, committee chair, and officer.

Number of Meetings/Events: See the program structure outline on the application for specific numbers of meetings and events. Members are required to attend at least 75% of meetings and events.

Working Events: Members are required to work a number of statewide events at the Ohio State Fair, and elsewhere throughout the state (Farm Science Review, Legislative Luncheon, etc.). Each level of membership differs in the number of events that are required. See the program structure for more information.

Location of meetings: Meetings are typically held at the Ohio 4-H Center in Columbus, Ohio, but there are occasionally instances when they are held elsewhere due to events on Ohio State's Campus. In these instances, meetings may be held at locations close to campus. Refer to the application for the locations for the 2020-2021 year. Members will be notified prior to the location change.

Additional Opportunities: Depending on the level of involvement, council members have the option to apply for additional opportunities including the National 4-H Conference, Ohio 4-H Foundation Board, and other opportunities that may arise.
