- To collect your well water sample properly:
- Use a clean container (empty plastic bottle) that can be sealed and holds at least 1 litre of water
- ***FIRST DRAW***For Lead & Copper
- Fill your container with the **first draw of water** in the morning (or after 6 hours of non-use)
- **REFRIGERATE**
- All results are **CONFIDENTIAL**

Educate yourself about your water!

Stop by anytime during the event. It will take about 30 minutes to receive your free test results. While you are waiting stop at our different booths to learn more about your water...

- Locate your house on a county map and find out about well logs
- Observe a groundwater model in action- learn about aquifers, bedrock, wells, and water movement
- Talk to a local well driller
- See a well casing up close
- Learn how to properly sample your water for bacteria
- Talk with a health representative at the county and state level
- Learn about proper soil nutrient management
- Learn about proper stormwater management
