

September Garden

Now is the time to perform the usual fall duties such as continuing to harvest, weed, pull dead or diseased plants, (remember these do not go in the compost), and plan to enrich soil for next season.

However, do not forget It is not too late to plant for fall harvest. There are many cold hardy and frost tolerant plants that can do well in the Ohio garden even through December.

Semi Hardy plants that can withstand a light frost: Beets, carrots, Chinese cabbage, chard, cilantro, leaf lettuce. Hardy Plants that tolerate a hard frost: collards, kale, kohlrabi, mustard greens, radish, snow peas, spinach, turnips.

So, while you are out there working in the garden this fall, plant a cold and or frost tolerant vegetable! It after all, why we have a garden to begin with!
