Take I-75 North to exit 61 merge onto I-70 E toward Columbus. Use exit 36 for OH-202/Old Troy Pike. Turn left. Drive north 3.8 miles. Destination on right.

FROM NORTH:

Take I-75 South to exit 68 for OH-571/Tipp City. Turn left on OH-571. Left on OH-202. Destination on right.

FROM EAST:

Take I-70 W toward Dayton. Use exit 36 OH-202/Old Troy Pike. Turn right. Destination 3.8 miles north on right.

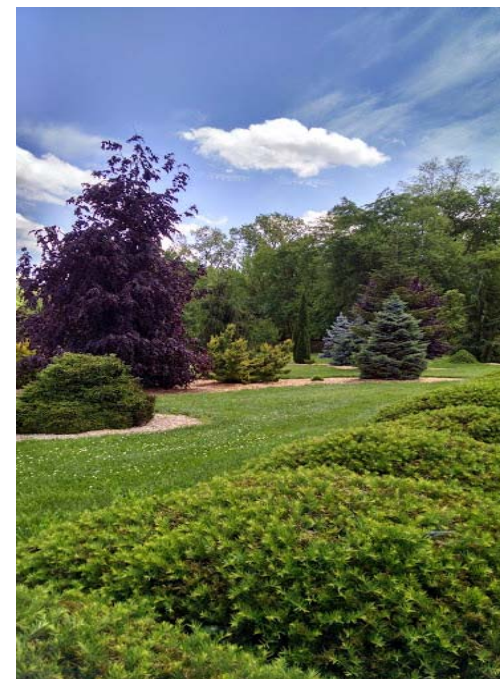

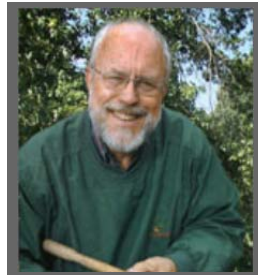

Registration is \$60 per person includes tour, talks, lunch and handouts



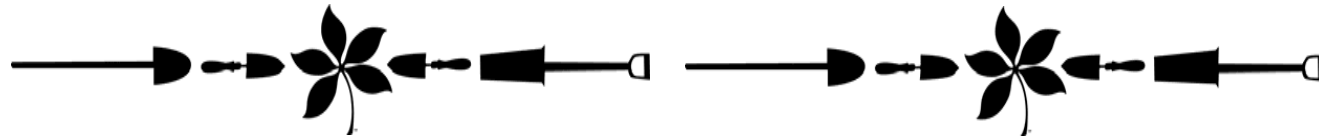
Fred Hower
